THE STARTER REPORTED:

- a) TEQUILA TANGO reared in the stalls and dislodged Jockey G Wright without incident. This colt was taken out the stalls, examined by the Veterinarian, passed suitable to race and reloaded, causing a delay. Thereafter, TEQUILA TANGO was slow into stride.
- b) WILD STREAK and FLOWER BURST jumped slow, losing one length.
