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THE STARTER REPORTED:

- a) RULES OF CONDUCT rushed the front gates as the start was effected, reared, jumped awkwardly, losing one length and thereafter, was slow into stride.
- b) BANDMASTER rushed the front gates.
- c) ATLANTIC PEARL jumped outwards.

THE STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORTED:

- a) On arriving at the start, the Jockeys reported a horse shoe on the track at approximately the 700m. A Handler was dispatched to remove it.
- b) ATLANTIC PEARL jumped awkwardly outwards and made slight contact with CHIEF RUNNER shortly after the start.
- c) RULES OF CONDUCT was hanging in in the straight and proved difficult to assist. The Stewards determined that the combination of the incident at the start and the fact that this gelding was difficult to ride in the straight accounted for its below par performance.
- d) Jockey MK Katjedi reported that, in his opinion, BANDMASTER was distressed at the pull up. The Veterinarian was requested to examine this gelding.
- e) ATLANTIC PEARL returned with a bilateral epistaxis due to an exercise induced pulmonary haemorrhage and is suspended for a period of 60 days from racing in any race under the jurisdiction of The National Horseracing Authority of Southern Africa in terms of Rule 93.1. (Dr K Davis). Trainer WGC Miller was advised.

- a) PEEKABOO was slow into stride.

THE STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORTED:

- a) All horses selected for TCO2 were within the required levels and no retests were recorded. (12h39)
- b) Jockey KA Brewer was given permission to hack HARPA to the start.
- c) At approximately the 1300m, QUEEN OF CASTILLE shifted inwards, clipped the heels of DEAD POETS SOCIETY, stumbled and dislodged Jockey E Webber. In this incident, PEEKABOO had to take evasive action to avoid the fallen Rider.

Jockey E Webber was attended to on course by the paramedics. This precluded Jockey E Webber from being able to weigh in. In terms of Rule 66.2, the Stewards were satisfied that QUEEN OF CASTILLE had carried the correct weight.
QUEEN OF CASTILLE was taken in hand post-race, examined by the Veterinarian and nothing obvious was detected.
- d) GREEN POINT shifted both ways away from the crop from the 300m.
- e) Jockey K Strydom reported that GOLDEN FIFTIES made an abnormal respiratory noise in running. The Veterinarian was requested to examine this gelding.
- f) Jockey KA Brewer reported that he felt something amiss with HARPA. The Veterinarian was requested to examine this filly.
- g) PRICELESS TREASURE, the winner, was selected for the taking of specimens for analysis. Assistant Trainer FJ Jacobs, acting on behalf of Trainer DG Smith, was advised. (LM)
