The Stipendiary Stewards examined all the racing equipment belonging to the Jockeys and Apprentices prior to Race 1 at today's race meeting. All concerns were addressed, the necessary measures were taken to ensure compliance with the Rules and the Jockeys and Apprentices were advised that their racing equipment would be checked on a regular basis in future.

Jockey E Webber did not ride at today's race meeting as he was medically indisposed.

Jockey R Fourie submitted a clearance from the Japan Racing Association, stating that he is free of any embargo and was clear to ride at today's race meeting.

THE STARTER REPORTED:

- a) AMERICAN PETAL bolted the course, was taken in hand, examined by the Veterinarian and withdrawn.
- b) AMERICAN GEM was stubborn loading.
- c) ROCKING IN RIO jumped slow, losing one length.

THE STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORTED:

- a) All horses selected for TCO2 were within the required levels and no retests were recorded. (11h40)
- b) AMERICAN GEM had to be steadied when awkwardly placed between the inside running rail and J LORDI, which shifted inwards at the 800m turn.
Apprentice BA Makhubo was charged with a contravention of Rule 62.2.7 in that as the rider of J LORDI, he failed to ensure that he did not cause interference to AMERICAN GEM at the 800m. Apprentice BA Makhubo signed an Admission of Guilt and is suspended from riding in races for a period of 7 days. (Dates: 12/09/2026 – 18/09/2026, both dates inclusive).
It has come under the notice of the Board that Apprentice BA Makhubo has been suspended on numerous occasions with regard to his riding on the turn, specifically at the 800m. A recommendation has been made to the Academy Master that extra attention be given to Apprentice BA Makhubo's riding in an effort to rectify this.
- c) J LORDI shifted inwards away from the crop from the 300m, without correction.
Apprentice BA Makhubo appeared before the Board and was advised to change his crop hand timeously to assist his mount to keep on a straight course in similar circumstances.
- d) NORSE WARRIOR shifted out away from the crop shortly before the finish.
- e) AMERICAN PETAL bolted to the start and had a severe bilateral epistaxis due to an exercise induced pulmonary haemorrhage and was withdrawn by the Veterinarian. This filly is suspended for a period of 120 days from racing in any race under the jurisdiction of The National Horseracing Authority of Southern Africa in terms of Rule 93.1. (Dr J de Villiers). Assistant Trainer M Sobethwa, acting on behalf of Trainer SB Kotzen, was advised.
- f) ROCKING IN RIO, the winner, was selected for the taking of specimens for analysis. Trainer AC Greeff was advised. (LM)
